

CLUB COVID REQUIREMENTS

17th February 2021

Clubs competing in the Club Circuit AUTUMN 2021 season have provided the following COVID requirements that must be observed by all players. These requirements should be read in conjunction with all current government rules and regulations.

Bentleigh Club

Sign in using **Service Victoria** app

Competing players only - **No visitors**

2 players per court, gallery viewing area is restricted to 10 people – 2 people permitted on landing area.

No wiping of hands on court walls.

Wipes are provided outside all courts to sanitize door handles.

Supper requirements to be finalized by 7:30pm.

- Suppers will be served by a single person from home team.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

It is recommended that players bring their own water bottles.

Grace Park Hawthorn Club

Sign in books and QR scanning is available and must be filled in upon entry.

Face masks only required when physical distancing cannot be guaranteed.

Squash courts: Restricted to 42 per levels or as per Squash Court Covid Plan

Patrons in food and beverage areas are permitted to stand but must comply with social distancing rules.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

Suppers will be either plated by the chef or served by the GPHC captain.

KLTC

KLTC will host guests for supper in all leagues

There may be accommodations to the service (for instance no shared central plates)

Amended the facility entry process due to construction

- We recommend off-site parking. Vision Australia, across the road is the best option usually
- To access the courts, Players must enter via the rear doors beside the Pro Shop
 - This is found by facing the main entry and walking to the left of the clubhouse then down the railway side. As soon as you can turn right past the clubhouse, walk to the entrance that is 20 meters along and on the right.
 - Non-members can knock to get the attention of attendants who will let them in.
- All members must be screened and signed in

- This will take some time and if they want to make the process quicker, they can advise Kooyong 9822-3333 of the names of all players attending at least 3 hours before arrival.

Aside from Guardians in the case of juniors, only players who have a match on that evening will be able to attend

Players are requested to leave the court area reasonably quickly after all matches are completed

Players are requested to use their own phones and the **ScoreSquash** app for marking as no scoresheets will be provided

NOTE: Access to the bar is no longer simple and the water fountains are not in use, nor can we provide drinks at court level. It is highly recommended that players bring their own water bottles.

The usual COVID requests are in place

- Do not attend the club if you have any symptoms
- Until further notice, masks are required indoors.
- Maintain 1.5 meter distance when off court wherever possible.
- Clean doors between each match. No equipment sharing.

Minimize contact and no handshakes etc.

The dining facility is considered a separate venue for contact tracing purposes there will be an additional aspect for players to be aware of.

- A Form will be available in the squash area to be filled by the captains prior to 7.30pm – names & phone for contact tracing in the dining rooms and supper attendance confirmation
- Form will be collected around 7.30pm by a Kooyong staff member

Lilydale Club

Sign in using **Service Victoria** app, or use the sign-in sheet at the front door.

Do not attend the club if you are feeling unwell.

Under the current guidelines masks are required upon entry to the club.

No wiping of hands on court walls. It is recommended players bring a small hand towel onto the court.

Wipes are provided outside all courts to sanitize door handles.

Suppers will be served by a single person from the home team.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

It is recommended that players bring their own water bottles.

Maintain a physical distance of 1.5 metres where possible

MCC

Sign in QR coding as you enter Melbourne Sports Centre

Sanitise hands on entry

Any player showing symptoms of cold/flu/covid19 etc. will be refused entry into the facility

All players must register on arrival with MCC Squash by signing in

There will be no wiping of hands on side walls or glass back of court

No shaking hands with anyone.

Players to bring a sweat towel to wipe any excess sweat they create while playing

Players to bring their own water bottle – there is a water fountain available

No spectators unless accompanying a minor

Players will have access to the facilities including showers/ change rooms

Any player who begins to feel unwell will be told to stop play immediately and to leave the facility and seek medical advice, take a COVID test and report on the results

Suppers will be provided as per usual arrangement

Mulgrave Country Club

ONLY SYMPTOM FREE PLAYERS AND VISITORS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE MULGRAVE COUNTRY CLUB

All state and federal government restrictions are to be adhered to at all times.

Attendance:

ALL players and visitors must register and sign in and out at Reception before entering and exiting the squash court area.

- By signing in, each player and visitor agrees to the facility terms and conditions.
- Attendance records will be retained by the Club's Centre Management in the event Government contact tracing is required.
- Players and visitors are permitted to go into other areas of Mulgrave CC in line with Club rules but must only enter via the main reception doors to maintain adherence with strict numbers policy.
- All Players and visitors to undertake contactless temperature check in foyer before proceeding to the court area. The device will flash green if within government guidelines. If you fail the check, a siren and red flashing light will be sounded and notification sent to the facility manager to promptly attend. At this stage you will be asked to evacuate the building and seek medical advice.

Hygiene:

- There will be no wiping of hands on side walls or glass back of court, any coughing or sneezing should be into a towel or elbow of arm, no shaking hands with anyone
- Players to bring a sweat towel to wipe any excess sweat they create during the session
- Players to supply their own racquets for the session, there is to be no sharing of equipment amongst courts
- Players are required to bring their own bottled water for rehydration, access to refill water bottles will be available at the water cooler
- Court door handles and glass wall are to be sanitized or disinfected following each session by those players before allowing the next booking players on the court

Court Area and Change Rooms:

- A maximum of 20 spectators allowed in the upstairs gallery and 20 people in the downstairs court viewing area
- Players and visitors to maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres as per guidelines.
- Score sheets will be available if required.
- The toilet, showers and change rooms are accessible. Steam room remains closed.
- The wearing of Masks will be governed by the DHHS rules at the time

Suppers:

Suppers will still go ahead as per normal. Staff will provide table service for service of food and drinks. If staff are not available the home team will have a person nominated to serve drinks and food on behalf of guests.

RACV

Sign in using the QR code on display at the Squash Courts.

Supper will be provided as usual.

Cleaning spray and wipes are provided for players to clean high touch points such as the court doors.

Hand sanitizer is provided in an automatic dispenser.

Showers and change room facilities available; players must bring their own towels and soap/shampoo (if they use it!)

We request that players limit visitors as much as possible.

In regards to venue capacity and mask wearing, we adopt government regulations and signage at the venue is indicative of these measures.

RSY

Sign in using **QR code** upon entry

RSY will be providing supper as per usual.

Other than ever changing government regulations, RSY will apply standard COVID safe practices.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

Sandringham

Sign in using **Service Victoria** app

No visitors allowed.

No wiping of hands on court walls.

Supper requirements to be finalized the day before scheduled match.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

The Squash Melbourne Club

Check in is via our QR code or written details at the reception area.

Our COVID rules require, currently, a mask to be worn on entry and in the non-playing areas unless food or beverage is being consumed.

Supper provided in the club room at Squash Melbourne.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

We also request that players do not wipe their hands on the court walls and suggest they have a small towel to place at the front of the court

Veneto Club

Scan in using QR codes

Only competing players allowed – definitely no visitors

Viewing gallery to have only four people per court

- Additional 2 players in lower viewing area – behind court

All players to provide own water bottle

Scoring via app only – NO scoresheets.

Wipes provided in lower viewing area to sanitize door handle

We request hands not wiped on walls and glass. Own towel (small) can be placed in front of court.

Showers and change rooms available – bring own towel

Supper will be served as by a home team member – 4 people per table.

Westerfolds

Sign in using QR scanner.

Suppers will be cooked and served by the staff.

Face masks to be worn while regulation is in effect while you are not playing or eating supper.

Showers and change rooms are available – no towels provided.

The staff member on will do regular cleaning of touched surfaces around the building and change rooms.

Sanitizing wipes outside courts for players to sanitize door handles immediately before/after touching a handle.
