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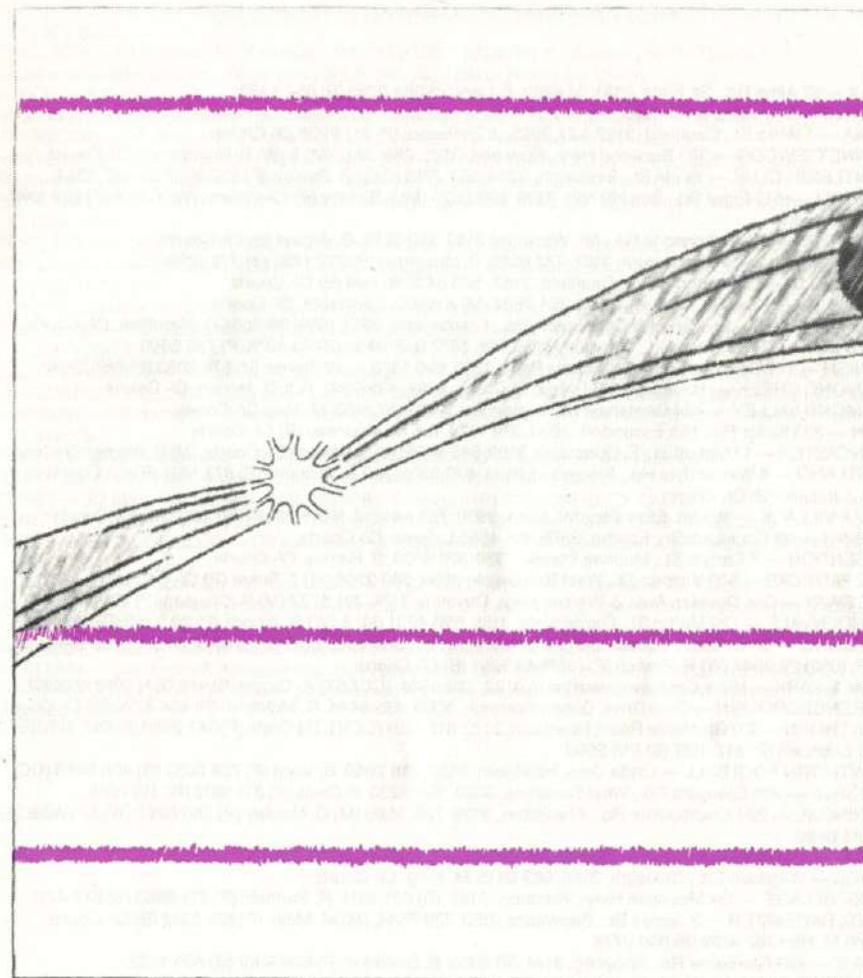

HANDY HINTS FOR TEAM CAPTAINS AND PLAYERS

- Arrive early so matches commence at advertised starting times.
- It is the responsibility of all home teams to provide respectable suppers.
- All Captains are reminded that the toss of a coin should take place prior to the first match for help in deciding disputes or appeals.
- Players are reminded of Rule 9 of the V.S.R.A. General By Laws relating to the rules and etiquette of the game, 'matches shall be played under the rules of the game of squash rackets as determined by the International Squash Rackets Federation, the interpretation of which shall devolve upon Council unless otherwise indicated by these By Laws, and players shall observe the etiquette of the game and refrain from unseemly or improper behaviour on and off the court while present at a pennant match and its associated events.'
- Note that at private Clubs no track suits are allowed. Neat casual dress only.
- Fine for non attendance by markers/referees for finals matches is \$50.

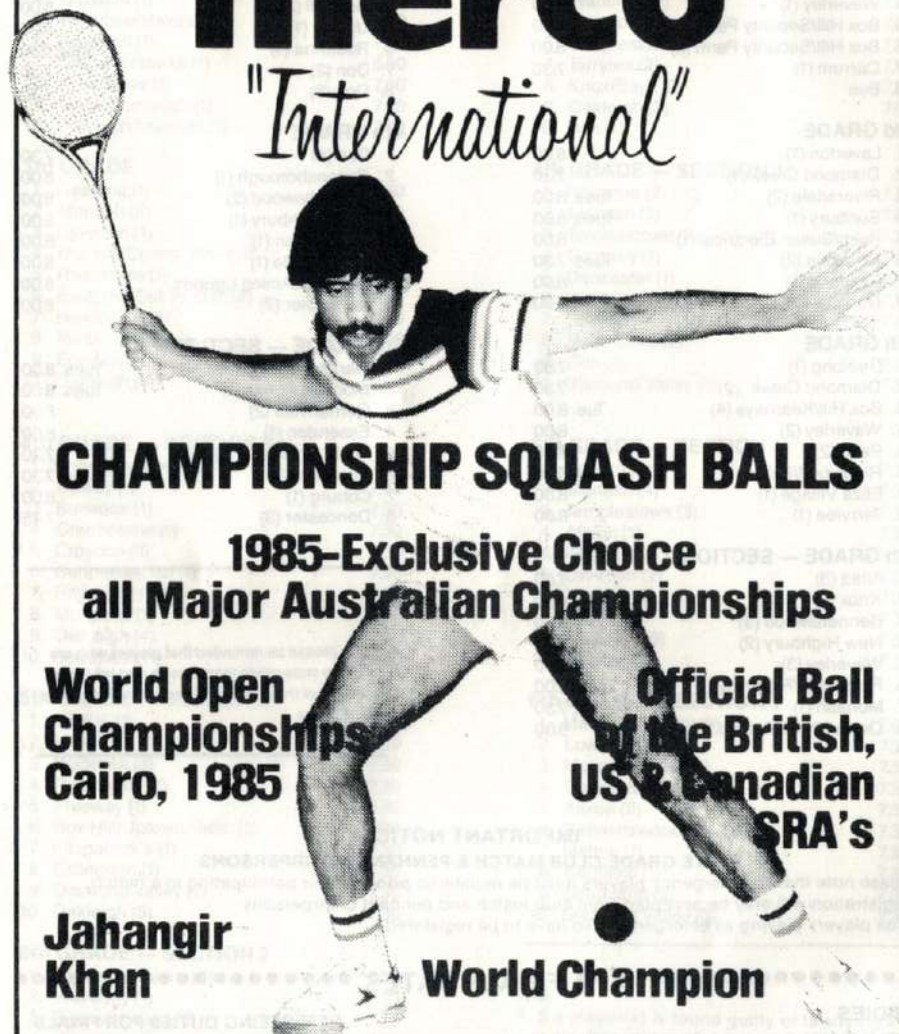
