GRAPHITE TALK

Remember when a graphite frame was a graphite frame? Well, the use, placement and composition of graphite has greatly matured in frame technology. The following information has been prepared by Tension 24 in an effort to keep you up to date on current frame technology:

MODULUS: Refers to the specific grade of graphite. Modulus describes the stiffness of a material; units of modulus are typically units of force divided by area (pounds per square inch). The higher the modulus, the stiffer the material and better its strength-to-weight ratio; hence its desirability as a material in composite sports equipment (i.e. bicycle frames, golf shafts, tennis racquets). Graphite modulus is usually described in MSI or millions of pounds per square inch. Normal graphite, for instance, has a higher modulus than fibreglass and high modulus (HM) is stiffer than low modulus (LS). Due to the substantial cost of producing HM graphite, most frames utilize a smaller proportion (typically 5% to 25%) of HM to medium or LM graphite. HM graphite is usually added at specific locations, depending on the discretion of the designers and engineers.

Note that despite its performance aspects, stiffer graphite is also more brittle. Theoretically, frames with a larger percentage of HM graphite can be more susceptible to breakage.

ULTRA HIGH: Tensile modulus of 90 MSI.

VERY HIGH: Tensile modulus of 70 MSI.

HIGH: Tensile modulus of 40-50 MSI.

MEDIUM: Tensile modulus of 30 MSI.

Unidirectional: (GRAPHITE PLACEMENT) Graphite fibres oriented towards one direction during the manufacturing process.

This method allows for preferential placement of materials (shoulders, head) and the best strength-to-weight and stiffness-to-weight ratios.

Short (or Chopped) Fibres (Graphite): Typically used in injection moulded frames, these fibres are added to the resin prior to injection into the frame mould.

Woven Graphite: A material form in which the yarns (filaments or bundles) are interlaced in a bi-directional pattern (at right angles, for example). The modulus of woven graphite is commonly lower than that of uni-directional forms due to the structural placement of the weave.

Braided Graphite: A material form manufactured in a textile-type process wherein a number of yarns are intertwined (braided) for added strength.
