NOTICE TO ALL CLUBS

Finals Information

Club Circuit is one of the only squash competitions that subsidise grand finals. However some players are unaware of the details and eligibility of the finals situation.

- Note:**
- **Semi-Finals:** The bottom team of each grade at round 12 generally hosts, scores, referees and provides the ball. Club Circuit no longer provides a \$50 subsidy and all costs must be shared by the competing clubs.
 - **Grand Finals:** The losing team of the semi-final referees and scores the match. Club Circuit will make all arrangements and pay court hire, ball and supper costs for the eight competing players and four umpires. All drink and other costs to be paid by the competing clubs.
 - **Eligibility:** Participating players must have played 5 games with **the club** that season not necessarily the team. The exception is 4 if there is a bye in the Club Circuit grade or if the C.C. match committee grants special permission. Players **can not play down** from the grade above in finals. Players **can not play across** from the same grade in finals. **Any queries about any of the above, contact Barry Taylor, Match and Pennant Chairman.**

Special Requirements

- **ALMA CLUB:** Regulation squash attire is to be worn on court. No tank tops, football shorts, football socks or bike shorts.
- **BENTLEIGH CLUB:** Neat Casual, no tracksuits, running shoes or t-shirts in main club area.
- **MELBOURNE CRICKET CLUB:** Gates are locked at 8.15pm. Admittance cannot be gained after that time.
- **NAVAL & MILITARY CLUB:** Jacket and Tie must be worn for admittance to the Club
- **R.A.C.V. CLUB:** Jeans, t-shirts, tracksuits, sports shoes and thongs not accepted, in main club area.
- **ROYAL SOUTH YARRA CLUB:** Jacket and tie are no longer compulsory, however neat and casual attire is required.
- **SANDRINGHAM CLUB:** No ladies admitted without permission.
- **ST KILDA FSC:** Tracksuits not to be worn in licensed and bistro areas.

NEAT ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALL CLUBS
NON-COMPLIANCE WITH DRESS REQUIREMENTS MAY
RESULT IN THE REFUSAL OF ADMITTANCE TO ANY CLUB.

V.S.R.A. CLUB CIRCUIT - 2002 SPRING SEASON

1. All emergency players must be registered **PRIOR** to their participation in a match.
2. Registration can only be made by contacting Barry Taylor (0404 034 610), or Club Circuit Secretary.
3. A player cannot play twice on the same night in any competition.
4. Registrations will only be accepted from Club Match and Pennant Chairpersons.
5. Players "filling in" in a higher grade must be from their club's next immediate grade.
6. Where a club has two teams in the same grade, it may be possible for the player to play for the other team in special circumstances, but requires the prior permission of the Match & Pennant Chairperson.
7. **ALL PLAYERS** must be present at the venue of the match **PRIOR** to the official starting time.
8. The order of the rubbers **SHOULD** be decided by the toss of a coin.
9. **MID SEASON CHANGES:** must be submitted in writing or fax and forwarded to Barry Taylor, Match and Pennant Chairman at Round 7. There will be no appeals to Match and Pennant Committee regarding Mid-Season team changes.
10. If a match has to be abandoned, the host team captain must notify the Match and Pennant Chairperson A.S.A.P., who will advise when the match is to be played.
11. If a player(s) is found guilty of falsifying a match result card, a severe penalty will apply.
12. Players wearing singlet tops, tracksuits or thongs are not permitted to enter the bar area or supper room of private clubs.

NOTES FOR CLUBS, CAPTAINS & PLAYERS

RUBBERS

Captains and Clubs should encourage all players to be in attendance for all rubbers and suppers. If a player is to be delayed or late, the opposition must be notified prior to play and if possible by telephone as early as practical.

WALKOVERS

Where a walkover is to occur, the opposition must be advised by telephone as early as possible.

RESULT SHEETS

When filling out the result sheet, note all requirements, e.g. full names, grade, section, date, points, round number and Club. Do not forget to sign the result sheet when complete. A lack of any of these will result in a \$10 fine.

BAD COURT BEHAVIOUR

Bad court behaviour will not be tolerated during pennant matches and should be reported to your Club Committee and relayed by them to the Club Circuit Match and Pennant Chairperson for the appropriate action.

MARKING AND REFEREEING

Marking and refereeing of pennant matches shall be carried out by the members of each team. A person from each team shall officiate at each rubber, the roles of marking and refereeing being alternated for each consecutive rubber. If the Captains fail to agree, the roles of marking and refereeing of the first rubber shall be decided by the toss of a coin.

MARKERS CALL

The marker must call to stop a rally if, in his/her opinion, a player failed to deliver a good service or to make a good return. The Marker must also call the score, "hand out", "fault", "foot fault", "not up", "down" and "out" when appropriate.

TEAM WALKOVER

Where a team walkover is to occur, Clubs please note that payment must be made within fourteen days of invoice or teams are liable to lose pennant points. Points so lost will not be re-instated upon late payment.

SUPPERS

All home teams must provide a reasonable standard of suppers and adequate refreshment should be provided at the end of each match and at supper.

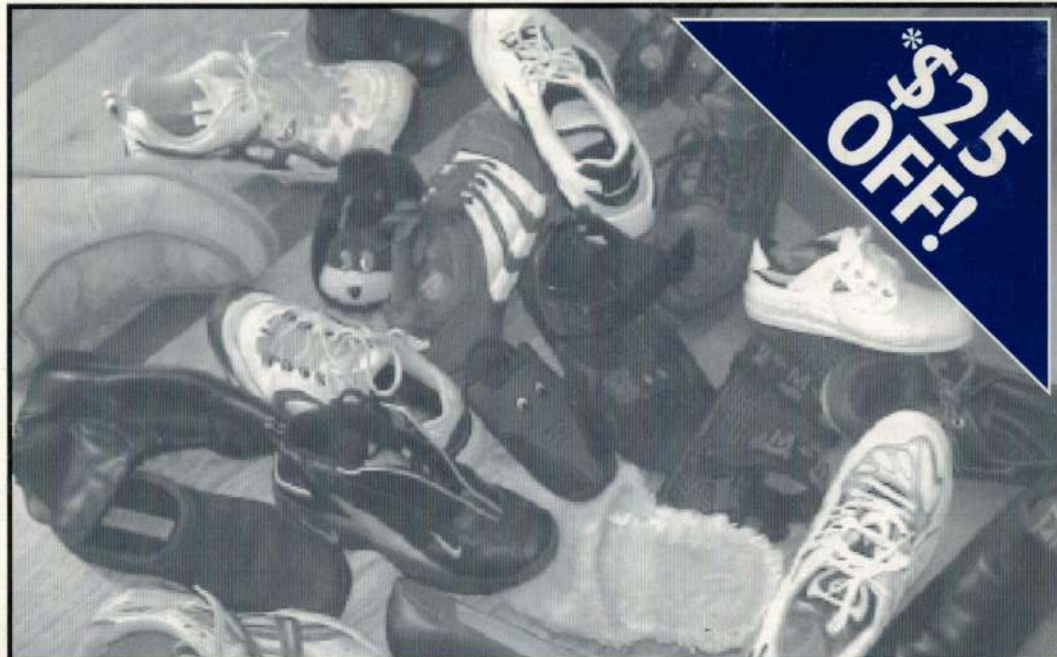
