NOTICE TO ALL CLUBS REGARDING PENNANT FINALS

Club Circuit is the only squash competition in Melbourne that subsidise grand finals. However some players are unaware of the details and eligibility of the situation.

SEMI-FINALS:

The bottom team of each grade at round 12 generally hosts, scores, referees and provides the ball (including a spare ball readily at hand during each final).

The competing clubs on agreement must share drinks and food costs with team captains.

GRAND FINAL:

The losing team of the semi-final scores and referees the match.

Club Circuit will make all arrangements and pay court hire, squash ball (including a spare ball readily at hand during each final) and supper costs for the eight competing players and four referees.

All drink and other costs to be paid by the competing clubs on agreement with team captains.

ELIGIBILITY:

Participating players must have played 5 games with the club that season not necessarily in the team.

The exception is 4 games if there is a bye in the Club Circuit grade or if the Club Circuit match committee grants special permission.

Players **can not play down** from the grade above in finals.

Players **can not play across** from the same grade in finals.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

ALMA CLUB	Regulation squash attire is to be worn on court. No tank tops, football shorts, football socks or bike shorts.
BENTLEIGH CLUB	Neat casual, no tracksuits, running shoes or t-shirts in the club area.
KOOYONG CLUB	Smart casual clothes allowed. Shirts worn in bar area must have collars.
MELBOURNE CRICKET CLUB	Home matches played at Grace Park, Kooyong and RACV – comply with appropriate clubs requirements.
NAVAL AND MILITARY CLUB	Jacket and tie must be worn for admittance to the club.
RACV CLUB	Jeans, t-shirts, tracksuits, sports shoes and thongs are not accepted in the main club area.
ROYAL SOUTH YARRA CLUB	Jacket and tie are no longer compulsory, however neat and casual attire is required.
SANDRINGHAM CLUB	No ladies admitted without permission. Neat and casual attire is required.
ST KILDA FSC	Tracksuits not to be worn in licensed and bistro areas.

NEAT ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALL CLUBS

PLAYERS WEARING THONGS OR SINGLET ARE NOT TO ENTER THE BAR AREA OF CLUBS

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH DRESS REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN THE REFUSAL OF ADMITTANCE TO ANY CLUB

VSRA CLUB CIRCUIT - 2003 SPRING SEASON

1. All emergency players must be registered **PRIOR** to their participation in a match.
2. Registration can only be made by contacting Barry Taylor (0404 034 610) or the Club Secretary.
3. A Player cannot play twice on the same night in any squash competition and cannot play for any two Club Circuit clubs in the same season.
4. Registrations will only be accepted from the Club Circuit Match and Pennant Chairperson.
5. Players 'filling-in' in a higher grade can be from any lower team playing in order of merit.
6. Where a club has two teams in the same grade, it may be possible for the player to play for the other team only in the same order number or higher. Players cannot play across during finals.
7. **ALL Players** must be present at the venue of the match **prior** to the official starting time.
8. The order of rubbers **SHOULD** be decided by the toss of a coin.
9. **MID SEASON CHANGES:** must be submitted in writing or fax and forwarded to Barry Taylor, Match and Pennant Chairman, at round 7. There will be no appeals to Match and Pennant Committee regarding mid-season team changes.
10. If a match has to be abandoned, the **host team** captain must notify the Match and Pennant Chairperson **ASAP**, who will advise when the match is to be re-played.
11. A severe penalty will apply if a player(s) is found guilty of falsifying a match result sheet.

NOTES FOR CLUBS, CAPTAINS AND PLAYERS

RUBBERS

Captains and Clubs should encourage all players to be in attendance for all rubbers and suppers. If a player is delayed or late, the opposition must be notified prior to the start of play and if possible by telephone as soon as practicable.

WALKOVERS – TEAM or INDIVIDUAL

Where a walkover is to occur, the opposition team must be advised by telephone as early as possible. The home team must send the completed score sheet to the Match and Pennant Chairperson; failure may result in a fine on the club giving the walkover.

RESULT SHEETS

Complete all requirements when filling out the result sheet, e.g. full names, section, date, points, round number and club. Do not forget to sign the result sheet when complete. A lack of any of these could result in a fine.

BAD COURT BEHAVIOUR

Bad court behaviour will not be tolerated during pennant matches and should be reported to your Club Committee who will relay details to the Club Circuit Match and Pennant Chairperson for appropriate action.

MARKING AND REFEREEING

The members of each team shall carry out marking and refereeing of pennant matches. A person from each team shall officiate at each rubber, the roles of marking and refereeing being alternated for each consecutive rubber. If captains fail to agree, the role of marking and refereeing of the first rubber shall be decided by the toss of a coin.

MARKER'S CALL

The marker must call to stop a rally if, in his/her opinion, a player failed to deliver a good service or to make a good return. The marker must also call the score and appropriate calls, e.g. hand-out, fault, foot fault, etc.

SUPPERS

All home teams must provide a reasonable standard of supper and adequate refreshment should be provided at the end of each match and at supper.

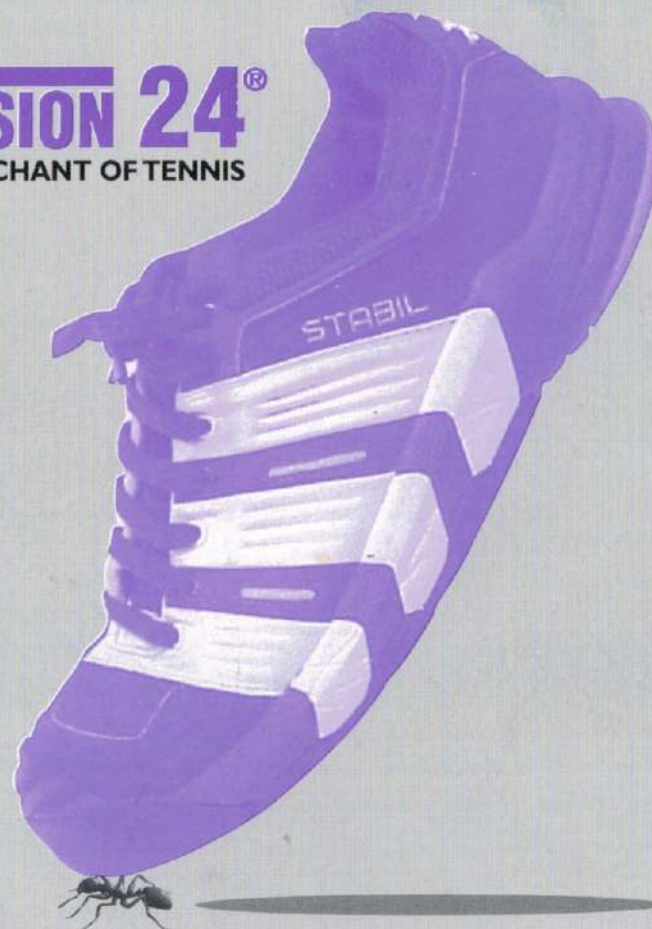
