NOTICE TO ALL CLUBS REGARDING PENNANT FINALS

Club Circuit is the only squash competition in Melbourne that subsidise grand finals. However some players are unaware of the details and eligibility of the situation.

SEMI-FINALS:

The bottom team of each grade at round 12 generally hosts, scores, referees and provides the ball (including a spare ball readily at hand during each final).

The competing clubs on agreement with team captains must share drinks and food costs.

GRAND-FINALS:

The losing team of the semi-final scores and referees the match.

Club Circuit will make all arrangements and pay court hire, squash ball (including a spare ball readily at hand during each final) and supper costs for the eight competing players and four referees.

All drink and other costs to be paid by the competing clubs on agreement with team captains.

ELIGIBILITY:

Participating players must have played 5 games with the club that season not necessarily in the team. The exception is 4 games if there is a bye in the Club Circuit grade or if the Club Circuit match committee grants special permission.

Players can not play down from the grade above in finals.

Players can not play across from the same grade in finals.

NOTES FOR CLUBS, CAPTAINS AND PLAYERS

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All players must be registered **PRIOR** to their participation in a match. Registration can only be made by the Match and Pennant Chairman, Barry Taylor (0404 034 610), or in his absence, the Club Secretary. This ruling particularly applies to a player 'filling in' as an emergency in a team during the season as the player must be registered before squash insurance is applicable.

CONDITIONS OF PLAYING

A Player cannot play twice on the same night in any VSF affiliated squash competition unless it is finals and permission is given by the Association Match and Pennant Chairman.

A player cannot play for any two Club Circuit clubs in the same season.

MATCH ATTENDANCE

All Players are strongly recommended to be in attendance prior to the scheduled starting time and throughout the match and at supper. A player who is delayed or late must notify the team captain by telephone as soon as practicable to enable the opposition to be notified prior to the start of play.

MARKING AND REFEREEING

The members of each team shall carry out marking and refereeing of pennant matches. A person from each team shall officiate at each rubber, the roles of marking and refereeing being alternated for each consecutive rubber. If captains fail to agree, the role of marking and refereeing of the first rubber shall be decided by the toss of a coin.

TWO TEAMS IN SAME GRADE

Where a club has two teams in the same grade, a player is eligible to play for the other team only in the same order number or higher. Players cannot play across during finals.

PLAYING 'UP'

A play can play 'up' in a higher grade at the lowest order of play available in that grade.

PLAYING 'DOWN'

The number 3, 4 or 5 in a team may play 'down' as a replacement for the number 1 in the next immediate team provided that team is not more than two grades lower. The Match and Pennant Chairman must approve playing 'down' if more than two grades lower.

MID-SEASON CHANGES

Mid-season team changes must be forwarded in writing or fax to Barry Taylor, Match and Pennant Chairman, at round 7. There will be no appeals to Match and Pennant Committee regarding mid-season team changes.

WALKOVERS - TEAM or INDIVIDUAL

Where a walkover is to occur, the opposition team must be advised by telephone as early as practicable. The home team must send the completed score sheet with details of the walkover to the Match and Pennant Chairperson; failure may result in a fine on the club giving the walkover.

ABANDONED MATCH

If a match has to be abandoned, the host team captain must notify the Match and Pennant Chairperson ASAP, who will advise when the match is to be re-played.

RESULT SHEETS

Complete all requirements when filling out the result sheet, e.g. full names, section, date, points, round number and club. Do not forget to sign the result sheet when complete. A lack of any of these could result in a fine. A severe penalty will apply if a player(s) is found guilty of falsifying a match result sheet.

BAD COURT BEHAVIOUR

Bad court behaviour will not be tolerated during pennant matches and should be reported to your Club Committee who will relay details to the Club Circuit Match and Pennant chairman for appropriate action.

SUPPERS

All home teams must provide a reasonable standard of supper and adequate refreshment should be provided at the end of each match and at supper.

PLAYER SQUASH INSURANCE

Insurance is provided for injuries caused solely by active participation in officially organised games, practice and training and official function.

A player is eligible for insurance cover if you are a financial member of your club and are currently registered to play competition pennant with the VSF or any of its affiliate associations. Club Circuit is an affiliate member. If you are injured obtain a Sports Injury Claim Form from the Victorian Squash Federation office (Ph: 9682 2199) or download a form:

Accredited coaches who are affiliated with Squash Australia and/or its member associations or affiliates must wear approved Protective Eyewear when coaching Juniors.
